**Apply now for the SAIS German Studies Summer Program 2008**  
**May 31 – June 14, 2008**

The German Program of the Johns Hopkins School of Advanced International Studies invites you to participate in the **German Studies Summer Program 2008: “The Berlin Republic and its Eastern States in the New Europe”**, a two-week Study Program and Tour of Berlin, Eastern Germany (Dresden, Leipzig, Potsdam, and the German/Polish border region).

The Study program includes:

- Lectures, site visits and roundtable discussions on Germany’s foreign policy, the enlarged Europe, transatlantic relations, global politics, immigration, domestic policy, environmental and climate change questions.
- Meetings with prominent policy makers, scholars, representatives of governmental, nongovernmental and cultural organizations, the media as well as the private sector.
- Guided tours of political and government sites (*Bundeskanzleramt*, *Bundestag*, *Auswärtiges Amt*), *Viadrina Europa-Universität* in Frankfurt/Oder and the *Colloquium Polonicum* in Slubice.
- Program of diverse cultural activities (theater, cinema, museums, readings etc.)

**Students of the European Union Studies Consortium Program in Washington D.C.** qualify to apply for *Transatlantik-Fellowships*, offered by the German Government, which will cover most of the program expenses (airfare, all transportation in Germany, accommodations, food, receptions, guided tours, seminars, cultural activities such as theater, museum etc.)

- Students’ fee is 1980 USD (may vary due to exchange rate)
- Proficiency knowledge of German at least at the intermediate high level is required.
- US/Canadian citizens are encouraged to apply.
