

**A 2-day workshop for Ph.D. students on EU politics to be held at the Hanse Wissenschaftskolleg, Germany on May 9-11, 2008.**

The fellowships will cover by receipt economy travel expenses (up to €750). Local accommodation and meals in Delmenhorst will be covered.

1. A single-authored research paper, or an outline of your dissertation project (2,000 to 8,000 words).
2. A letter of recommendation emailed directly by your dissertation advisor.
